Mildred B. Sloth (1918-2016)

CEDAR FALLS- Mildred B. Sloth, 97, of Cedar Falls died Wednesday, February 17, 2016 at NewAldaya Lifescapes in Cedar Falls.

She was born December 30, 1918, in Fairfield Township, Iowa, daughter of John Taylor and Carrie M. (Petersen) Nielsen. She married Henry E. Sloth on February 28, 1942 in Kahoka, Missouri. He died December 1, 2003.

Mildred owned and operated a dance studio, was the Clerk for the City of Dike, and then was Secretary to the Superintendent at Dike High School. She had been actively involved with the Cedar Valley Danes, Danish Sisterhood, Dike American Legion Post 471 Auxiliary, Fredsville Historical Committee, and Yesterday Antique Club.
