Norma Ann Spurgeon (1926-2019)

CEDAR FALLS – Norma Ann Spurgeon, 93, of Cedar Falls died Wednesday, August 28, 2019 at the Western Home Communities – Elizabeth E. Martin Health Center.

She was born March 1, 1926 in Freeport, Illinois, daughter of Louis P. and Clara M. (Soldati) Marietta. She married Dorse Spurgeon on May 24, 1952 in Waterloo, Iowa. He preceded her in death on February 7, 1993.

Norma graduated in 1944 from St. Mary's in Waterloo and was employed in the lunch program at St. Patrick Catholic School in Cedar Falls. She was a member of the Catholic Daughters of Waterloo and St. Patrick Catholic Church.
