Norman D. Caley (1948-2015)

SUMNER- Norman D. Caley, 66, of Sumner and Harpers Ferry, died Tuesday, January 27, 2015 at Windsor Nursing and Rehab Center, Cedar Falls.

He was born February 27, 1948 in Waterloo, son of Donald "Red" and Elizabeth Arends Caley. He married Joyce Schutte on August 2, 1969 in St. John Lutheran Church, Waverly.

He graduated from Cedar Falls High School in 1966 and was employed with Viking Pump IDEX for 47 years, retiring as shop supervisor. Norman enjoyed being outdoors, especially hunting and fishing. Many of his post retirement years were spent on the Harpers Ferry cabin remodeling project. As a recent volunteer with the Rapid Resource Project he observed and reported the activities of the Peregrine Falcons nesting on the bluff above the cabin.

Survived by: his wife, Joyce of Sumner and Harpers Ferry; two sisters, Bonnie (Larry) Hughes and Cathy Fencl, both of Cedar Falls; mother-in-law, Ruth Schutte of Waterloo; two brothers-in-law, Dale (Wendy) Schutte of Harpers Ferry and Joe (Lin) Schutte of Cedar Falls; a sister-in-law, Beverly Gill of Waterloo; and numerous nieces and nephews.
