CEDAR FALLS- Paul E. Braun, 74, of Cedar Falls, died Monday, May 10, 2010, at his home.

He was born August 27, 1935, in Sumner, the son of Edward H. and Marie A. Aschbrenner Braun. He married Darlys Kirchhoff on October 24, 1956 in Tripoli.

He graduated from Sumner High School in 1953, and served in the United States Navy from 1954 to 1958. He owned and operated B&G Heating from 1970 to 1990, then was employed with Cedar Falls Utilities from 1990 to 1999. After retirement, he was a tremendous asset to Performance Bodies in the Cedar Falls Industrial Park. He loved spending time with his family, especially his grandchildren, playing golf, and being of service to others.
