



## Philip Berg

November 18, 1925 - January 12, 2009

CEDAR FALLS- Philip S. Berg, 83, of Cedar Falls, died Monday, January 12, at Western Home Communities Martin Center.

He was born November 18, 1925 in Cedar Falls, son of John P. and Edyth Schuneman Berg. He married Ilene C. Harold on May 1, 1954 in Mason City.

Mr. Berg served in the Army Air Corps during WWII and the United States Air Force during Korean Conflict. He graduated from the University of Iowa and the School of Banking, University of Wisconsin. He was with First National Bank in Cedar Falls from 1955 until joining Midway Bank and Trust when it was chartered in 1961 and served as its President from 1964 to 1987. He also served as their chairman of the Board of Directors and served as chairman of the Marketing Committee for Iowa Transfer Service, Inc. He was past president or chair of: Sartori Hospital Board of Trustees, Cedar Falls Chamber of Commerce, Rotary, United Way fund drive, UNI Parents Assoc., Metropolitan Hospital Council, the County Bankers Association, Board of Governors for the UNI Foundation, Board Member of ITS, and the Arcturus Club. He was named Representative Citizen of Cedar Falls in 1988.

Survivors include his wife, Ilene of Cedar Falls; two daughters, Lisa A. Berg of St. Paul, MN and Nancy K. (Jeff ) Johnson of Minburn, IA; five grandchildren; and four great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents and a brother, John R. "Jack" Berg of Cedar Falls.

Services will be held 11:00 a.m. Friday at First Presbyterian Church in Cedar Falls, with private inurnment at Fairview Cemetery, Cedar Falls later this spring. Military Honors will be given at the church by Cedar Falls AMVETS Post #49. Friends may call one hour prior to the services at the church

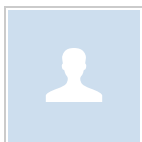
