Dr. Philip Rohrbaugh (1937-2015)

CEDAR FALLS- Dr. Philip Rohrbaugh, 77, of Cedar Falls, died Saturday, April 11, 2015 at the Cedar Valley Hospice Home in Waterloo.

He was born October 6, 1937 in Cleveland, Ohio, son of John Russell and Catherine Glen (Elder) Rohrbaugh. He married Winifred Lloyd Myers on June 25, 1960, in Le Roy, New York.

He graduated from College of Wooster and then Case Western Reserve School of Medicine. He was a family physician with Medical Associates/Covenant Clinic for 31 years, retiring in 2004.
