CEDAR FALLS- Raymond N. Kane, 87, of Cedar Falls, formerly of Fairbank, Iowa, died Friday, April 12, 2013, at his home.

He was born July 21, 1925 in Oran, Iowa, son of John and Frances (Fettkether) Kane. He married Beverly J. Gallup on March 13, 1947 in Cedar Rapids. She died October 10, 2002.
