CEDAR FALLS- Richard F. Boorum, 64, of Cedar Falls, died Saturday, April 3, 2010 at the Cedar Valley Hospice Home, Waterloo.

He was born January 13, 1946 in Cedar Falls, the son of Francis C. and Adeline A. (Cooper) Boorum. He married Mary Jane Luze on October 24, 1970 in Traer, IA.

Richard was employed with Viking Pump Co. for forty years, as an Engineering Pump Specialist, and also held an Iowa Nursing Home Administrators License. He was Past President of the Cedar Falls Y's Mens Club, and held memberships with the Civil War Round Table, both Cedar Valley and Cedar Rapids chapters; the 37th Iowa (Gray Beards) Civil War Reenactment Group; and the Iowa Pioneering Cemetery Association. He was an active member of the First Baptist Church in Cedar Falls, serving as past Trustee and Youth Group Leader.

He was preceded in death by two brothers, Lyle and Roger Boorum.
