Richard Crane, of Cedar Falls, passed away early Saturday, September 17th at the age of 59.

Rich is survived by four brothers: Michael (Pam) of Clovis, CA, J.C. of Omaha, NE, Bruce of Waterloo, IA, and Tom (Vickie) of Cedar Falls; seven children: Boon and Amy, Matt (Danielle), Nichole, Ashley (Bo), Jamie, and Erik; and twelve grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, Fred and Virginia, siblings Jan, Tim, and Paul, and his wife, Dianna.

Rich was a lifelong Cedar Falls resident who worked incredibly hard for his family. He laid miles of concrete on local bridges, the Campanile, and the Wellness Center at UNI. His love of the outdoors led him to become an arborist with the City of Cedar Falls and Wright Tree Service as well as an expert landscaper with Green Team. Rich loved to fish, ride Harleys, read, watch Westerns, and listen to music, especially The Beatles. He was also known to answer almost every question on Jeopardy! Rich was incredibly humble and had two favorite sayings that ruled his life: "Right is right," and "Courtesy costs you nothing." Although short in stature, he was a giant of a man to those who knew and loved him.
