CEDAR FALLS- Richard E. "Red" Hundley, 67, of Cedar Falls, died Thursday, September 24, 2009 at Covenant Medical Center.

He was born December 9, 1941 in Iowa City, the son of Delwin and Ruth Marie (Avery) Hundley. He married Billie Joyce Smith on March 25, 1961 in Finchford.

Mr. Hundley graduated from Finchford High School in 1959 and began his employment with Coca Cola Bottling in Waterloo.
