April 5, 1941 - July 16, 2023

Surrounded by his family, Richard “Dick” Swanson of Cedar Falls, Iowa, died after a brave four-year fight with cancer at his home on Sunday, July 16, 2023, at the age of 82.

Richard was born to Dena and Ivan Swanson in Cedar Falls on April 5, 1941. Both he and his wife, Karen (Juhl), graduated from Cedar Falls High School with the class of 1959.
