CEDAR FALLS-Robert L. "Bob" Curtis, 82, of Cedar Falls, died Friday, February 24, 2012 at the Western Home Communities-Martin Center. He was born October 25, 1929, in Cedar Falls, Iowa, the son of Lloyd N. and Lila Clemens Curtis. He married Helen Busch June 6, 1959, in Cedar Falls. Mr. Curtis graduated from Cedar Falls High School in 1948 and Iowa State Teachers College (UNI) in 1953, with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Social Science. He served in the Iowa Army National Guard for 35 years retiring as Master Sergeant. He was employed as a Police Officer with the Cedar Falls Police Department for 34 years, retiring in 1985. He then was an Instructor at Hawkeye Community College from 1985-2000. He served as President of the Cedar Falls Exchange Club in 1982.

Survived by: his wife of Cedar Falls; four daughters, Jeannette (Steve) Husome of Cedar Falls, Barbara (John) Makinster of Poway, CA, Cheryl Curtis of Cedar Falls, and Stephannie Phalen of W.
