CEDAR FALLS- Robert L. Drum, 79, of Cedar Falls died Saturday, October 16, 2010 at Allen Memorial Hospital, Waterloo.

He was born May 14, 1931 in Cedar Falls, the son of Leo A. and Elsie (Schroeder) Drum. He married Darlyce A. Smith on August 20, 1949 in Cedar Falls.

He was employed with the Cedar Falls Police Department for sixteen years, and then with the Black Hawk County Sheriff Department. He retired in 1974 from the City of Cedar Falls Parks Department.
