CEDAR FALLS- Robert D. Johnson, 89, of Cedar Falls died Thursday, January 17, 2013, at his home.

He was born August 25, 1923 in Cedar Falls, son of Thorvald and Maria (Comer) Johnson. He married Isabel Kelly on September 14, 1946 in Minneapolis, Minnesota.

He graduated from Teachers College High School and attended the University of Kansas and St. Ambrose College. He served five years in the U.S. Navy, serving in the Pacific theater during World War II. He worked as an insurance agent eventually establishing Johnson, Bailey and Associates. He was an active member of Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Cedar Falls, for 68 years.
