Robert Lakin (1927-2017)

CEDAR FALLS – Robert Lakin, 90, of Cedar Falls died Thursday, November 2, 2017 at NewAldaya Lifescapes in Cedar Falls.

He was born October 25, 1927 in Mower County, MN, the son of Harry and Mrytle Thompson Lakin. He married Dorothy Wilson June 11, 1949, at First Baptist Church in Cedar Falls.

Robert graduated from Cedar Falls High School in 1945. He was employed in tool and die for Chamberlains in Waterloo from 1945 until his retirement in 1990. He served in the United States Army with the 2nd Mountain Division during the Korean Conflict.
