Bob was born August 27, 1921, in Moline, Illinois, the son of Dan and Elsie (Hayes) Sachau. He graduated from Port Byron High School in 1939 and then attended the University of Illinois. He went on to serve his Country in the United States Army during World War II and the Korean Conflict. On November 2, 1943, he was united in marriage to Virginia D. Wiley.
