Robert Lee Weidemann, 65, of Walker, MN (formerly of Cedar Falls, IA) died unexpectedly at the Veterans Memorial Hospital in Minneapolis, MN on Tuesday March 13th, 2012.

He was born July 30, 1946 in Cedar Falls, IA, the son of Harold and Edith Weidemann. He married his high school sweetheart Teri Thorsrud on October 28th, 1967.
