CEDAR FALLS-Robert J. "Bob" Young, 89, of Cedar Falls, died Saturday, May 3, 2014 at the New Aldaya Lifescapes in Cedar Falls.

He was born June 30, 1924, in rural Volga, Iowa, the son of William and Ella (Schmidt) Young. He married Carol E. Brockway August 31, 1952, in Arlington, IA. She died March 19, 2006. He served in United States Marine Corps during World War II.
