Ronnie R. "Ron" Streed (1942-2011)

CEDAR FALLS- Ronnie R. Streed, 68, of Cedar Falls, died Wednesday, March 2, at University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics following Cardiothoracic Surgery.

He was born June 17, 1942 in Wichita Falls, Texas, son of Rodney E. and Sally L. (Hartman) Streed. He married Christine S. "Crit" Campbell on June 1, 1971 in Cedar Falls.

Ron graduated from Bushy Park Central High School, London, England. He served as a medic in the US Army during Viet Nam. He graduated from the University of Northern Iowa in 1968 with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Art Education, and received his Masters from UNI in 1978. He was an Art Instructor with the Cedar Falls School System for thirty-two years retiring from Holmes Jr. High in 2001. He also taught art at international schools: Lincoln School in Katmandu, Nepal, and Colegio Interamericano, Guatemala.

Survived by: his wife, Crit; two brothers, Denny and Terry Streed, both of Orlando, FL; and two sisters, Kathy Armstrong of Orlando and Jenny Selig of Antreville, South Carolina.

Preceded in death by: his parents and a daughter, Somer Campbell Streed.
