RoxAnne G. Lang (1922-2013)

CEDAR FALLS- RoxAnne G. Lang, 90, of Cedar Falls, died Monday, May 27, 2013, at Western Home Communities Elizabeth E. Martin Health Center.

She was born August 14, 1922, in Wishek, North Dakota, daughter of Philip J. and Mary A. (Dietrich) Koch. She married Ludwig C. "Lewie" Lang on April 2, 1942, in Napoleon, ND. He died August 20, 1991.

She graduated from Napoleon High School in North Dakota and then from Young's School of Beauty. She owned RoxAnne's Beauty Shop, operated out of her home.
