June 9, 1943 - September 16, 2024

Samuel Steven Genolous, 81, died on Monday, September 16, 2024, at Pinnacle Specialty Care in Cedar Falls. We were grateful to have surprised him for his 80th birthday last year with so many friends and family.

He was born on June 9, 1943, in Waterloo, IA, the son of Thomas and Bernice (Smith) Genolous. He graduated in 1961 from Waterloo East High School. On November 25, 1962, he was united in marriage to Sandra Sue Lines, they had dated from the age of 12 and they were married for 48 years before she earned her crown in heaven. Everyone knew Sam as the “best car salesman.” He retired from Community Motors in 2014.

Sam lived out his last years needing to know every detail of his children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren's lives so that he could pray for them each day.
