Sandra Kay Krebs, 83, of Freeport, TX, died on Sunday, November 26, 2023, at Jennie Sealy Hospital in Galveston, TX.

She was born on December 27, 1939, in Waterloo, IA, the daughter of Leo and Luella (Burger) Krebs. She grew up in rural La Porte City and graduated from high school in 1958.
