



Shelly Lynn Gebert

August 8, 1971 - May 19, 2022

Michelle “Shelly” Lynn Gebert, age 50, formerly of Cedar Falls, died unexpectedly at MercyOne Hospital in Oelwein on Thursday, May 19, 2022.

She was born August 8, 1971, in Cedar Falls, the daughter of Tom and Julie (Cuvelier) DeGroot. Shelly graduated from Aplington High School in 1989 and received a degree in nursing. She worked as a licensed practical nurse for New Aldaya Lifescapes in Cedar Falls. On May 12, 2012, she was united in marriage to Kenny Gebert in Waterloo.

Shelly dedicated her life not just to taking care of her residents at New Aldaya, but also caring for animals. She is highly regarded in the community of animal rescue for her commitment to finding perfect homes for dogs and cats alike, spreading awareness of the importance of fostering and adoption of animals, and her strength for taking on even the most challenging or difficult animal cases. Her compassion has inspired others not only from her rescue, Cedar Valley Pitbull Rescue, but those from other rescues as well.

Shelly is survived by her husband; one son, Zachary (Maureen) DeGroot of Cedar Falls; two daughters, Kayla DeGroot of St. Cloud, MN, and Samantha Tuecke of Oelwein; her father, Tom DeGroot of Cedar Falls; and her sister, Lori (David) Schilling of Cedar Falls.

She was preceded in death by her mom, Julie DeGroote; and her brother, Darren DeGroote.

A funeral service will be held at 11:00 a.m. Wednesday, May 25, 2022, at Richardson Funeral Service in Cedar Falls. Visitation will be one hour prior to the service. Inurnment will be in Greenwood Cemetery in Cedar Falls on Thursday, May 26, 2022, at 1:00 p.m.
