Stanley E. Durbin, 79, of Cedar Falls, Iowa, died Monday, July 18, 2011 at Allen Memorial Hospital in Waterloo.

He was born April 30, 1932 in Des Moines, Iowa, the son of Elmer and Ruby (Merriam) Durbin.

On May 22, 1964, he was united in marriage to Gean Gersema in Cedar Falls. Stanley served in the US Army during the Korean Conflict. In 1957, he graduated from Iowa State University with a degree in Civil Engineering. He was employed with Cedar Falls Utilities as a Civil Engineer and Land Surveyor.

Stanley was an avid St. Louis Cardinals fan and member of First United Methodist Church in Cedar Falls, where he taught the Growing Christians class for twenty-six years.
