CEDAR FALLS- Stuart N. Stilling, 61, of Reno, Nevada, died Saturday, March 21, 2015, from ALS.

He was born May 29, 1953 in Calgary, Alberta, Canada, son of Ernest and Ann (Meronek) Stilling. He married Janell Rosenberg of Cedar Falls, on July 1, 1996 in Las Vegas.

He earned his BA from UC Fullerton, MA in Clinical Psychology from Fielding Graduate University, and was currently working toward completion of his doctorate in Clinical Psychology. He was a professor of psychology at the University of Phoenix, retiring in 2014.

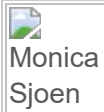
