Terry Joseph Hudson (1961-2019)

CEDAR FALLS – Terry Joseph Hudson, 57, of Cedar Falls died Saturday, May 18, 2019 following an accidental fall at home.

He was born September 7, 1961 in Riverside, Calif., son of Warren Lee and Clara Juanita (Tafoya) Hudson. He married Keri Roberts on May 12, 2007 at Nazareth Lutheran Church in Cedar Falls.

He graduated from Cedar Falls High School in 1979 and served in the U.S. Navy. He earned his Bachelors degree in Public Relations from the University of Northern Iowa in 1988. He was employed with the Tri-City Herald in Kennewick, Wash., and then was an education reporter and opinion page editor for the Waterloo/Cedar Falls Courier. He was later employed with Amperage Marketing and most recently was Community Representative for Care Initiatives Hospice.

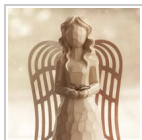
