Thomas A. Doeden (1924-2017)

CEDAR FALLS – Thomas A. Doeden, 93, of Cedar Falls died Monday, May 22, 2017 at Western Home Communities Elizabeth E. Martin Health Center.

He was born January 13, 1924 in Sinclair, Iowa, son of Englekes W. and Ella (Bergman) Doeden. He graduated from New Hartford High School in 1942. He married Ila M. Austin on March 16, 1947 in Shell Rock, Iowa.

He served in the United States Navy during WWII and attended Pasadena City College in California. He was employed as a Machinist in California for 16 years and then was a Machinist Instructor with Hawkeye Tech for 16 years, retiring in 1986.
