Timothy "Skinny" Van Dorn (1945-2010)

CEDAR FALLS- Tim "Skinny" Van Dorn, 64, of Cedar Falls, died Monday, August 16, 2010 at Covenant Medical Center.

He was born October 17, 1945 in Waterloo, the son of Lyle and Dorothy (Holland) Van Dorn. He married Genevieve "Genny" Christen on February 28, 1970 in Waterloo.

He graduated from Waterloo Columbus High School in 1963 and served in the United States Navy during the Vietnam Era. He was employed with Cedar Falls Fire Department, retiring in July 1994.
