CEDAR FALLS – Tom Koehn, 68, of Cedar Falls, died Thursday, Dec. 24, at home. He was born Sept. 16, 1947, in Waterloo, son of Lester and Pearl Koehn. He married Nancy on July 5, 1972, in Grand Junction, Colorado.

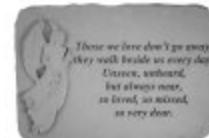
