V. Jean Pierce, 92, died on Wednesday, January 22, 2025, at her home in Cedar Falls.

She was born on May 24, 1932, in Marshalltown, Iowa, the daughter of Bruce Clinton and Viola Catherine (Price) Miller. She married Peter M. Pierce on November 1, 1952. After Peter died in 1995, she married Gene W. Crisman in 2001. He preceded her in death in 2010.

Jean graduated from Marshalltown High School then attended nurses training at Evangelical Deaconess Hospital School of Nursing in Marshalltown. Jean worked as a secretary for local stock brokerages. After 28 years at Securities Corporation of Iowa, she retired as a stock and commodities broker for SCI in 1997.
