Verle L. Buck (1923-2018)

CEDAR FALLS – Verle L. Buck, 95, of Cedar Falls died Thursday, June 7, 2018 at NorthCrest Specialty Care in Waterloo.

He was born May 27, 1923 in La Porte City, Iowa, son of Charles “Art” and Nellie (Border) Buck. In 1946, he married Fairy Stoler in Kansas City, Missouri. She preceded him in death in December 1985. He then married Bonnie M. Davis (Hills) on January 3, 1987 in Waterloo.

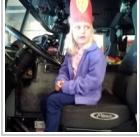
