June 21, 1921 - February 4, 2008

CEDAR FALLS- Vernon A. Nicholson, 86, of Cedar Falls died Feb. 4, at the Western Home Communities.

He was born June 21, 1921, in Waterloo, son of Harry and Olive (Paton) Nicholson. He married Marie Carolus on June 6, 1947. She died Sept. 22, 1999.

Mr. Nicholson served in the United States Army 101st Airborne during World War II. He was employed as a waste water operator with the city of Cedar Falls, retiring in 1985.
