Vicki Lynn Van Hauen, age 70, of Cedar Falls, died Monday, April 21, 2025, at MercyOne Medical Center in Waterloo

Vicki was born May 17, 1954, in Davenport, the daughter of Eugene and Jean (James) Mumm. She graduated from Davenport West High School in the class of 1972. On August 11, 1973, she was united in marriage to John Van Hauen in Davenport. Vicki received a bachelor's and master's degree in special education from the University of Northern Iowa. Her career was spent at River Hills School in Cedar Falls, and then 27 years at the Waterloo Public Schools, teaching special ed. Vicki retired in 2010.

After retiring Vicki enjoyed doing security for the Iowa Speedway (where she made many friends). She then spent her last several years working for guest services for her beloved Panthers at many sporting events.

She is survived by her husband, John Van Hauen of Cedar Falls; three children, John Jr. (Destiny) Van Hauen of Belle Plaine, Jasmine Van Hauen of Waterloo, and Katherine (Daniel) Johnson of Cedar Falls; grandchildren Anastasia, Trinity, Savannah, Peyton, Taylor, Ella, Jeri, Sydney, Logan, Sophie, Kaylin; and a sister, Cindi (Mel) Bates, of Long Grove, Iowa.
