Victor E. Kemming, 83, of the Western Home Communities-Martin Center, died Friday, October 28, 2005, at the Western Home.

He was born January 12, 1922, in Ida Grove, Iowa, the son of Chris and Augusta (Ackelbein) Kemming. He served his Country in the United States Army during World War II.
