CEDAR FALLS- Viola H. Smith Hoffman, 99, died Wednesday, July 28, 2010, at the Cedar Falls Health Care Center.

She was born December 14, 1910 near Aplington, the daughter of John and Minnie (Pruisner) Brandt. She married James Smith on February 23, 1931. They farmed near Buck Grove and Aplington. In 1946 she became a pilot and was one of the first flying farmers' wives in Iowa. Their marriage ended in divorce. She worked at Hinson Mfg for twelve years. In 1964 she married Leonard Hoffman till 1985.
