CEDAR FALLS – Warren Marshall Ferguson, 87, of Cedar Falls died Wednesday, May 13, 2020 at Western Home Communities Deery Suites.

He was born November 10, 1932 in Shellsburg, Iowa, son of Raymond and Gladys (Sanders) Ferguson. He married Janelle Peterson on March 1, 1953 in Vinton, Iowa. She preceded him in death on November 29, 2019.

He graduated high school in 1952 and served in the U.S. Army from 1953 to 1955, stationed in Europe. He then attended Iowa State Teachers College (UNI) and worked for Martin Bros. in Cedar Falls for 41 years, retiring in January 1995. He was a member of Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Cedar Falls.
