CEDAR FALLS – Warren Ronald Grapp, 82, of Cedar Falls died Saturday, August 10, 2019 at MercyOne Cedar Falls Medical Center.

He was born July 28, 1937 in Waterloo, Iowa, son of Elden and Edith (Fenner) Grapp. He married Nancy Richard on May 5, 1990 at the Little Brown Church in Nashua, Iowa.

He graduated from Cedar Falls High School in 1956 and served in the U.S. Army. He worked for John Deere in Waterloo and then was employed with the Cedar Falls Fire Department as a firefighter, then Assistant Fire Marshall and later a Fire Inspector, retiring in 1994.
