May 5, 1943 - May 11, 2006

Wayne was born May 5, 1946, in Waterloo, Iowa, the son of Glen and Clara (Furlong) Aldrich. He graduated from Waterloo West High School, and received his AA degree from Southwestern College in Chula Vista, CA, BA degree from Upper Iowa University in Fayette, IA, and MBA from Norwich University in Norwich, VT. He served his Country in the United States Navy during the Vietnam Era. On August 28, 1965 he was united in marriage to Michele Adney in Chula Vista, CA.
