CEDAR FALLS-Wendell George Welsh, 92, of Cedar Falls, died Saturday, November 23, 2013 at the Windsor Nursing and Rehab Center in Cedar Falls under hospice care.

He was born August 13, 1921, in Fairbank, Iowa, the son of Edward and Flossie West Welsh. He married Dorothy M. Miller August 14, 1943, in Oelwein, Iowa. She died April 2, 1997.

Mr. Welsh served in the United States Army during World War II with the 718th Railroad Battalion under the command of General George Patton, receiving 4 combat stars. He was a railroad engineer with the Illinois Central Railroad for 41 years, retiring in December of 1981.

Survived by: his daughter, Cheriee (Dr. Steven) Tarr of Cedar Falls and five grandchildren.

Preceded in death by: two sons, Wayne and Patrick Welsh; daughter, Renee Welsh; three brothers, Kenneth, LaVerne, and Ronald Welsh.

Mass of Christian Burial will be 10:00 a.m. Wednesday at St. Patrick Catholic Church, with interment in the Greenwood Cemetery, both in Cedar Falls.
