Wenona "Maxine" Ethington (1920-2014)

CEDAR FALLS- Wenona "Maxine" Ethington, 93, of Cedar Falls, died Thursday, April 17, 2014, at Covenant Medical Center in Waterloo.

She was born December 29, 1920, in El Dorado Springs, Missouri, daughter of Charles and Ruby Hemmet Caldwell. She married Edward "Dean" Ethington on June 26, 1943, in Nashua. He died January 12, 2011.

She attended high school in Lenox, Iowa, graduating in 1938 and was a homemaker throughout her adult life.
