William J. Denning, Jr. (1923-2008)

CEDAR FALLS- William J. Denning, Jr., 84, of Cedar Falls, died Monday, March 10, at the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics, following a stroke.

He was born Dec. 20, 1923 in Story City, the son of William J. and Margaret M. (Foes) Denning. He married Helen June Brown, and she preceded him in death in 1949. He married Doris M. Havig on June 24, 1950 in Nashua. She died April 9, 2005.

Mr. Denning served in the United States Army Air Corps during World War II and was employed as a Machine Operator with John Deere, retiring in 1987.
