William (Bill) Burton Mincks, age 96, of Cedar Falls, Iowa died July 4, 2024, at The Deery Suites. He courageously fought a 15-year battle with cancer up until the very end.

Bill was born January 28, 1928, near Centerville, Iowa, son of Ida (McGavran) and George R. Mincks. He graduated from Centerville High School and attended Iowa State Teacher's College (UNI), graduating with a BA in business.
