Wilma A. Hansen (1916-2018)

CEDAR FALLS – Wilma A. Hansen, 101, of Cedar Falls, died Friday, May 4, 2018 at Morningside Manor in San Antonio, Texas, where she had lived for the past ten years.

She was born September 22, 1916 in Laurens, Iowa, daughter of Donald J. and Ada (Keck) Handy. She married Harvey I. Hansen on February 2, 1935 in Cedar Falls. He preceded her in death on April 13, 1985.

She graduated from Laurens High School and attended Iowa State Teachers College. She was employed in Food Service at Cedar Falls High School for ten years, retiring in 1974. She was a member of First United Methodist Church in Cedar Falls.

Survived by: a daughter, Maryln Peterson of San Antonio; three granddaughters, Robin (Ted) Tragus and Ruth Peterson, both of San Antonio, and Carmen Nelson of Altoona; and three great granddaughters, Sabrina Tragus-Lopez, Beth Tragus, and Olivia Nelson.
