



Wilma Stallman

September 10, 1930 - March 24, 2024

Wilma Jean (Dawson) Stallman, 93, of Cedar Falls, died on March 24, 2024, at Deery Suites Western Home Community, Cedar Falls.

She was born to Lee and Emma (Chamberlain) Dawson in Des Moines, IA on September 10, 1930.

Wilma graduated from Albia High School and Iowa State Teachers College (now University of Northern Iowa) with an Elementary Education Diploma. Wilma taught at country schools and Van Eaton Elementary School, Waterloo.

She married Marvin Stallman in Waterloo in 1952. Wilma devoted her time to volunteer work in the kids' schools, her community, and church. She enjoyed square dancing with Marvin, and taught Janesville students how to do-si-do and promenade. Time was also spent in bowling leagues, card club, reading, and she always had her score book at her children's softball games.

Wilma is survived by her son Jeff (Andrea) Stallman, son-in-law David Carlson, grandchildren Tara (Brent) Young, Andrew (Andrea) Stallman, Kaitlyn (Anthony) Heibult, Aubrey (Alex) Streicher, great grandchildren Zanna Young, Stellan Young, Dean Heibult, and sister Norma Hopkins. In addition, there are nieces, nephews, extended family, and dear friends.

She was preceded in death by her husband Marvin in 2019, her parents, her daughters Jacqueline Stallman, Susan Stallman, and Cindy Carlson, and siblings Bud Dawson and Thelma DeWitt.

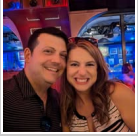
